Participation

- Only athletes that are a member of their national federation, recognized by the WKF, are admitted to participate.
- The competition is according to the rules of the Karate-do Bond Nederland (Dutch Karate Federation) and WKF.
- Single elimination system with repechage. For kata categories from cadets, the official WKF kata system will be used.

Registration

- All competitors, referees and coaches have to register online using the online system on www.sportdata.org. In case of any questions concerning the online registration please directly contact events@kbn.nl.
- Clubs, teams or federations are responsible for the entered registration data. It is mandatory to fill in the correct name, date of birth, weight (only for kumite) and upload a correct picture. Changes in the online data are possible until October 18th, 2024.
- All registered athletes will be put on the waiting list. After we have received the payment, we will confirm the entries.
- From October 18th until October 25th, changes in the online registration data because of incorrect, missing, or new registration data, are possible. A fee of €25 is charged for each change.
- The official registration session will take place on Friday November 1st 2024 from 15:00h until 19:00h at the Topsportcenter Almere. It is also possible to pick up the accreditation cards at Saturday or Sunday. On Saturday, this will be possible from 08:00h to 15:00h, on Sunday from 08:00h until 13:00h.
- At the registration session, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants main data, photograph and information about the registered categories. The accreditation card must be worn at all times during the event.

Registration fee

- All invoices related to the event should be paid at October 18th.
- Only after we have received the payment, we will confirm the entries.
- The registration fee for individual categories is €35,- per person.
- Payment of the entry fee only per club/association. Individual payments are not allowed.

- All teams have to register their participants at the official registration session.
- Only one representative per team has to register the complete team.
- All participants have to show their passports at the registration session.
- Maximum number of participants is 1000.
- Age and weight as it is during the registration date.
- Weighing is possible at:
 - Friday November 1st from 15:00h until 19:00h.
 - Saturday and Sunday from 08:30h until 30 minutes before the start of each category.
